Registration for the 2015 Northeastern North Carolina Craft Workshop begins on February 7, 2015 and will be accepted on a "first come-first served" basis until the April 2, 2015 deadline. Registration forms and class information can be requested from the Washington County Cooperative Extension Service, by calling 252-793-2163.

Registration fee is \$10 per day. All registration fees are non-refundable, but transferable, and must be received by April 2, 2015. Class kit fees vary depending on class selection. The workshop is designed and open to everyone and anyone interested in learning a craft whether hobbyist, adult or youth groups, craft teachers, small businesspersons, etc.

The 2015 workshop will be held on May 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> at the Vernon G. James Research & Extension Center located at the Tidewater Research Station on NC Highway 32 in Plymouth, NC. Hours are 9:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. daily.

Armenian Needle Lace; Basketry; Basic Stained Glass; Cottonwood Bark Carving; Decoy Carving and Painting; Embroidery; Glass Etching; Knitting-Beginner; Needle Felting; Painting in Acrylic; Sea Grass Stools; Silver Jewelry; and Yo-Yo Ornaments

The 2015 Northeastern NC Craft Workshop will be held on Tuesday, May 12 and Wednesday, May 13 at the Vernon G James Research and Extension Center, located at 207 Research Station Road, off Highway 32N, in Plymouth, NC. Registration is on a "first come - first served" basis. Registration fees are nonrefundable, but are transferable.

1. ARMENIAN NEEDLE LACE: two day class, Tuesday, May 12 and Wednesday, May 13. Students will learn the basic stitch, simple straight edging, and circles (doilies). Skills required: good eyesight (bring eyeglasses if needed); good use of hands (some slight disability with hands may be overcome). On day two, students will make doilies.

STUDENTS SHOULD BRING: small scissors; for comfort, maybe a cushion to sit on; eyeglasses, if needed

KIT WILL INCLUDE: all necessary supplies

BASKETRY - "Woven Vase": one day class, Tuesday, May 12. Students will weave with round and flat oval reed around a 2. glass ginger jar. Spokes will be inserted into a wooden base that is glued to the bottom of the jar. Some color choices will be available. Each vase will have some natural reed and one color. Students will learn to "chase weave", allowing continuous weaving. It will not be necessary to use a new weaver with each row. Techniques will include over-under weaving and twining. The rim will be lashed with waxed linen. The glass ginger jar serves as the mold and remains in the basket so the vase is usable. No prior weaving experience is required.

3. BASKETRY - "Shell Basket": one day class, Wednesday, May 13. Students will select a shell from North Carolina shells provided to be the base for the basket. Round reed will be used as the spokes. The spokes will be bound and the base will be twined. Each student will fit their base into the shell selected and then weave a basket that appears to grow out of the shell. Twining will be the primary technique used. There will be a variety of colors available as well as cords, wires, beads, etc. Each basket will be one-of-a-kind. No prior weaving experience is required.

5. **COTTONWOOD BARK CARVING:** two day class, Tuesday, May 12 and Wednesday, May 13. Students will carve a whimsical bark house out of cottonwood bark. This will be a wall hanging.

6. **DECOY CARVING AND PAINTING:** two day class, Tuesday, May 12 and Wednesday, May 13. Students will learn or sharpen carving skills to carve and paint a red-breasted menganser decoy. Decoy will be approximately ¾ life size – 12" long. Beginners will learn basic decoy carving and experienced carvers will sharpen skills using knives and rasps, with tupelo wood and acrylic paint. No experience is required, just be in the mood for some fun learning!
