1. BASIC STAINED GLASS: two-day class, Tuesday, May 10 and Wednesday, May 11. Students will learn safe handling of glass, glass cutting techniques, use of patterns and soldering in the copper foil technique. Students will create various sun catchers.

2. BASKETRY - "Smoked Reed Rectangular Wall Basket": one-day class, Tuesday, May 10. Students will weave with flat, flat oval and round reed and work over a mold to shape the rectangular wall basket. Basket will have a leather handle and rim will be lashed with waxed cotton cord. Weave patterns will include, but not limited to start-stop weave and triple twine. No prior weaving experience is required.
