RE: Parade and Parade Route

Thank you for your interest in participating in the 2019 Holiday Parade. This year's theme is "A Disney Christmas". We're excited to have you on board. Below are a few pointers for you to consider as you prepare for the parade.

Theme/Floats: We ask participants to incorporate their favorite Disney Characters or Disney Movie into their float/entry and that all vehicles and floats have lights.

Parade Check-In: All participants will enter College Way in front of the COA building. Due to congestion on the roadway, only the float itself will be allowed past the check-in point on College Way. Any group that is dropping off walkers/participants will need to do so at the entrance of the COA building and Maple Parkway. Vehicles that are not in the parade will not be permitted on Aviation Pkwy. Participants helping build a float or with supplies will have to park in PVA1(see Map) and carry supplies to their float's location. Parade participants may check-in as early as 3:00 pm. Parade participants can park at the NC Cooperative Extension, Currituck County Center. The parade starts promptly at 7 pm. **Please be aware that any group who has not entered College Way before 6:45 PM will not be allowed to participate in the parade!**

Judging: Judging is optional. Your \$20.00 entry fee puts you in the running to be awarded 1st, 2nd, 3rd place or Most Original. Trophies will be awarded to the winner of each category. Floats will be judged along the parade route.

Parade Route:

The parade route will begin on College way in front of the COA building. The parade will travel down Maple Parkway until we reach Community Way. The parade will turn on to Community Way and drive through the YMCA and N.C. Cooperative Extension Parking lots. Once at

Aviation Parkway, the parade will continue to the Barco Way intersection where parade participants can leave or stage in that area for pick up.

Parade Ending Point: The parade will end at the Barco Way intersection where parade participants can leave or stage in that area for pick up.

Holiday Festivities: NC Cooperative Extension will be hosting Reindeer Games prior to the tree lighting and parade beginning at 5:30, followed by the tree lighting at 6:30 in the courtyard between the Extension and Senior Center building. Come early, get checked in and participate in some of the fun events.
