- Basis planning techniques
- The relationship of the net investment income tax to S corporation shareholders
- Awareness of the built-in gains tax
- Strategies for using subsidiary corporations
- Structuring the purchase or sale of an S corporation

A dedicated tax school for organizations that have elected to be taxed as S corporations or LLCs. This advanced, directed-discussion online course covers formation, operation, contributions and cash distributions. This course emphasizes recent changes in law or rulings. Instruction also covers dissolution of an S corporation and impact of shareholders' choices on taxes. For example, contribution of property to the corporation upon organization can impact its subsequent sale. While the focus will be on closely-held corporations, the instructor may address all types of S corporation questions. Primary class material will come from the electronic course text: S Corporations: A Road Map for Tax Practitioners. The only prerequisite for this course is working knowledge of taxation, corporate structure and how flow-through works.
