4-H is the Youth Development program of North Carolina Cooperative Extension. The Currituck County 4-H program offers Summer Fun - a series of educational camps designed to build life skills through shared experiences and hands-on learning. Camps are open to ages specific to the age appropriateness of the activities.

- Space is limited, so once enrolled, your child is expected to attend and participate. If your child can no longer attend, please contact the 4-H Office as soon as possible so we can offer the space to the waitlist.
- Start and end times are enforced. Please arrive on time and pick up your children on time. We are unable to wait for late campers when departing for "away" trips, due to schedules established with our partnering organizations.
- If your child will be taking any medication (prescription or over-the-counter) during a 4-H camp,
 please advise the 4-H staff and supply the medication in a labeled container and instructions to the
 staff.
